Objectives

Students will be able to: 1) learn what water conservation is and why it is important, 2) Find out how easy it is to save water at home, 3) Work with their parents/guardians in installing water saving items inside their home

Method

Teachers will contact the Athens-Clarke County Water Conservation Coordinator to schedule a presentation for this class.

Overview

Students will learn about water saving tips for inside their homes and then be provided with free kits that include water saving items to be installed around their house. This activity helps students and parents/guardians work together to learn about water conservation. Students will be able to directly inform their parents/guardians about some of the ways they learned to save water during the classroom presentation, and how the devices they are installing will help in accomplishing that goal. A worksheet is also provided to help the members of the household assess how much water they are using per person per day, and how that amount ranks with others in the state of Georgia. The worksheet also provides numerous tips on saving water inside and outside the home.
